This section contains the student's course history. The courses listed are in the order taken and will contain the following information:

- · Name of School where the course was taken
- Month and Year the course was completed
- Student Grade Level when the course was taken
- Graduation Requirement the course will count towards
- Any special notations about the course

Listed below are the most common types of Courses and Credits listed on a transcript. If others show on your transcript, contact the school.

Prior to 9th grade credits – These will show as earned as an 8th grader at the Middle School. They will be counted the same as a Course taken at the High School.

Repeated Courses – Courses can be repeated for a higher mark or for credit when students fail a course. The original course will be marked with a small "R" to show it has been taken again. The marked course will not be counted in the GPA calculation.

Work in Progress (WIP) – These courses are populated from the student schedule prior to the completion of the Grading period. This does include courses scheduled at other PPS schools.

This section only shows the attendance history for PPS schools. It will include Elementary and Middle Schools if applicable.

Days Membership column represents the number of days present for the year listed at the PPS school.

The **Days Absences** column represents the number of days absent for that year. This number includes both Excused and Unexcused absences.



Graduation Requirements are based on the Diploma Type. The example is based on a Standard Diploma type.

Cumulative GPA - Weighted and Unweighted

- This calculation represents the average value of all the marks (A, B, C, D, F) earned for the high school courses.
- It is calculated by adding all the mark values (listed in the Grid) for each mark given and dividing this total by the number of courses taken.

Student's Class Rank

- This is based on the calculated GPA.
- Students are ranked from highest GPA (1 in their class) to the lowest GPA in their Grade Level.

Example: Student with all A's would have a 4.0 GPA.
