We are looking for children and households to take part in the CASCADIA Study! It only takes a few minutes to sign up.

WHY ARE WE DOING THIS STUDY?

We want to learn more about:

- How often COVID-19, flu, and RSV happen among children and adults
- How well COVID-19 vaccines protect people from COVID infection and illness

WHO CAN TAKE PART IN THIS STUDY?

You may qualify for this study if you are:

- 6 months to 49 years of age
- Living in or around Portland, Oregon

You do not need to be vaccinated to participate.

Whole households—or just children—can sign up (even if no adults take part).

WHAT WOULD I HAVE TO DO IF I TAKE PART?

If you take part, we will ask you to:

- Take a weekly home nasal swab and also tell us if you are feeling sick
- Visit our clinic one time per year and let us take a small blood sample
- Answer short surveys online or over the phone

We will test your swab for COVID-19, flu, and RSV and will give you the results every week!

You will receive gift cards to thank you for taking part in the study.
