



## Complete Course Requests Sheet

- Discuss your course requests with your family.
- Obtain all necessary signatures.
- Fill out the paper course requests sheet.

### Online Forecasting

- Log back into StudentVue. Under the course requests tab, watch the instructional video.
- Enter your requests. This should match what is on your paper sheet (Tip: only counselor's can add your 2<sup>nd</sup> choice for English and science classes)!

### Alternates Alternates

- Include alternate course requests for both your desired English class and for electives in rank order.
- This is *mandatory* as courses you have chosen may not be offered or fit into your schedule.

### Meet with your Counselor

- The final step will be bringing your forecasting sheet to meet with your counselor.
- Together you will discuss and lock your course requests in the system.
- Meetings will take place during English classes in Counseling
  - February 21-22, 25-26 for Juniors
  - February 12-15 for Sophomores
