Process Characteristics	Re-Norming In the Southeast Guiding Coalition
Sense of Urgency	<ul> <li>We are following a timeline and bound by the Kellogg MS reopening, but recognize that the process will be iterative</li> <li>Advisory Team is open to setting a realistic timeline moving forward</li> <li>Advisory Team is focused on the outcomes not the timeline</li> </ul>
Defensiveness	<ul> <li>PPS and FLO staff are open to feedback and endeavor to be responsive to needs of the members</li> <li>Open to both process and content improvement and committed to naming fears and how that may interrupt the process</li> </ul>
Quantity over Quality	<ul> <li>Guided by Racial Equity and Social Justice values and outcomes</li> <li>Importance of the Process and Community Engagement</li> </ul>

Process Characteristics	Re-Norming In the Southeast Guiding Coalition
Only One Right Way	<ul> <li>Multiple scenarios are being considered, scenarios are informed by multiple perspectives</li> </ul>
Either Or Thinking	Recognize that the solutions will need to be creative and complex
Right to Comfort	Group Agreements
Worship of the Written Word	<ul> <li>Dialogue is large part of meetings</li> <li>Maps and multiple charts as well as prose</li> </ul>




## Decentering Whiteness - Checking in

<b>Process Characteristics</b>	Re-Norming In the Southeast Guiding Coalition
Paternalism	<ul> <li>Coalition members are the key influencers of this process, staff is there to support and facilitate conversations to get to best recommendations</li> </ul>
Perfectionism	We recognize there is no perfect answer among so many complexities
Power Hoarding	Shared power model, parents as leaders
Fear of Open Conflict	More group discussions




## Feeder Patterns from Oct. 22

  - We're getting better every week!




#### 2019-20 SE Grade 6-8 Enrollment






#### 2024-25 Forecast SE Grade 6-8 Enrollment






#### 2019-20 SE Grade 6-8 Free Meals Rate






#### 2019-20 SE Grade 6-8 Neighborhood Race/Ethnicity






#### 2019-20 SE Grade 6-8 DLI Race/Ethnicity






#### 2019-20 SE Grade 9-12 Enrollment








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
#### Feeder Pattern 1: Grade 6-8 Enrollment




#### Feeder Pattern 1: Grade 6-8 Free Meals Rate






#### Feeder Pattern 1: Grade 6-8 Race/Ethnicity






#### Feeder Pattern 1: Grade 9-12 Enrollment








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
#### Feeder Pattern 3: Grade 6-8 Enrollment




#### Feeder Pattern 3: Grade 6-8 Free Meals Rate






#### Feeder Pattern 3: Grade 6-8 Race/Ethnicity


#### Feeder Pattern 4: Grade 6-8 Enrollment




#### Feeder Pattern 4: Grade 6-8 Free Meals Rate






#### Feeder Pattern 4: Grade 6-8 Race/Ethnicity




## Feeder Pattern 5: Grade 6-8 Enrollment




### Feeder Pattern 5: Grade 6-8 Free Meals Rate






# Feeder Pattern 8: Grade 6-8 Enrollment




### Feeder Pattern 8: Grade 6-8 Free Meals Rate





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


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# Feeder Pattern 9: Grade 6-8 Enrollment






### Feeder Pattern 9: Grade 6-8 Free Meals Rate
