Neighborhood School: enrolled primarily through its attendance area (aka boundary, neighborhood)



Neighborhood School Co-Located with Dual Language Immersion (DLI): neighborhood program enrolled through its attendance area, sited in the same school as DLI program(s) enrolled primarily through lottery



Focus Option or DLI Lottery School: whole school focus option or DLI enrolled primarily through lottery

School Colors



K-5 School: serves grades kindergarten through 5th and sometimes pre-kindergarten (aka Elementary School)



K-8 School: serves grades kindergarten through 8th and sometimes pre-kindergarten




6-8 School: serves grades 6th through 8th (aka Middle School)

Programs are within Schools










Nested Elements

Schools are within Attendance Areas (i.e., Feeder Pattern)



Note #1: Lottery-enrolled programs have a feeder pattern that does not depend on attendance areas, but usually stays within high school clusters. **Note #2:** In rare instances attendance areas are split (e.g., Lane MS attendance area is split between Cleveland HS and Franklin HS).

Draft Proposal A

Scenarios should be evaluated for their long-term and regional impacts. Phased implementation and high school changes will be recommended to the Board by district staff.



Scenario Summary

Middle schools: Harrison Park becomes the regional hub for Spanish and Chinese DLI programs and boosts neighborhood enrollment through attendance area expansion. Lane boosts enrollment through attendance area expansion.

Elementary schools: Bridger and Lent become regional hubs for Chinese and Spanish DLI, respectively. Clark becomes the neighborhood K-5 school for Harrison Park students. Attendance areas are adjusted to accommodate the dispersal of Bridger and Lent neighborhood programs and boost enrollment for schools no longer co-located with DLI.





Scenarios should be evaluated for their long-term and regional impacts. Phased implementation and high school changes will be recommended to the Board by district staff.



Scenario Summary

Middle schools: Harrison Park joins Kellogg in hosting Spanish DLI. Lane becomes the regional hub for Chinese DLI. Both Harrison Park and Lane expand attendance areas to further boost enrollment.

Elementary schools: Bridger and Woodstock become regional hubs for Spanish and Chinese DLI, respectively. Lent becomes a whole school Spanish DLI neighborhood program. Clark becomes the neighborhood K-5 school for Harrison Park students. Attendance areas are adjusted to accommodate the dispersal of Bridger and Woodstock neighborhood programs and boost enrollment for schools no longer co-located with DLI.

K-8 schools: Creative Science is moved to Arleta and enrolled through the neighborhood.















Draft Proposal A – Racial Equity Impact




Draft Proposal B – Racial Equity Impact








Cross-hatching in different directions based on K-5 or 6-8 boundary changes


