New BottleDrop Give Program: Stephenson PTA has started our own **BottleDrop Give Program** where proceeds from all Oregon 10-cent deposit containers go directly to our school. Here are the basics: pick up your pre-labeled blue bags from school, fill the bags with recyclable deposit containers, and drop them off at a nearby location to scan the deposit to Stephenson PTA's account. **Bags are now available in the office**.

Team Response Drill: The required emergency drill for the month of January is the Team Response Drill. This is in addition to our required monthly Fire Drill. Team Response is used when there is a medical emergency or a situation that requires staff to control movement inside the school. The team response is a tool we have that activates our school emergency team, clears our hallways of students and staff by having them return to their classrooms so that we can manage the emergency. Business as usual occurs in classrooms during a team response. Our drill will be Tuesday, January 21st at 10:35am.





Hello Stephenson Families,

OBOB practice battles for the 3rd -5th grade teams will begin next week. The battles will occur in the library wet space and in Room 158 during lunch recesses. We will have 15 teams this year. The official battles will start on Jan 21st. All 15 teams will have 2 battles and the top 8 teams with the highest cumulative

scores advance to a Double Elimination Bracket Tournament. The final battle will occur by February 14th. This will also give the final team to practice for the regional tournament on March 14th at Forest Park Elementary.

- K-2 students are learning friendship skills and problem solving (Ready, Set, Respect Program)

2020 STATE TESTING

As we close out the calendar year it is time we think about **STATE TESTING**. All 3rd-5th grade families will be given a copy of the **2019-2020** Annual Notice for Statewide Tests which has all the information you will need. A number of tests are administered to students each year.

They Include:

- *English Language Proficiency Tests (ELPA) given to students who receive English as a Second Language services in grades Kindergarten Fifth Grade.
- *Oregon Summative Assessments English Language Arts (OSAS) given to all students in grades 3-5.
- *Oregon Summative Assessments Mathematics (OSAS) given to all students in grades
- *Oregon Science Assessment given to students in grade 5

Oregon House Bill 2655 allows parents to "opt" their child out from all or some of the testing.

BOTTLEDROP GIVE

PURPOSE:

We all try and do our part to keep our environment healthy. We reduce, reuse, and recycle. Well, what if you could help your child's school benefit directly from what you're already doing?? **Well now you can!** Stephenson PTA has started a BottleDrop Give program where proceeds from all Oregon 10 cent deposit containers go directly back to the school. With your deposits, the Stephenson PTA can continue to make an impactful difference in the school experience for all students. Every container you recycle and bag you drop makes a difference.

WHAT CONTAINERS CAN I GIVE?:

Water	Soda/Pop	Fruit Juice
Beer	Hard Cider	Energy Drinks
Tea or Coffee	Coconut Water	LaCroix/Polar or other

FILL YOUR BAGS:

Fill the blue bags with Oregon 10 cent deposit containers. Your bags are prelabeled with a unique barcode so that your bag drop will directly benefit the Stephenson PTA. Plastic, aluminum, and glass can go in the same bag – no need to separate. Try to keep the bags under 20 lbs. Ensure the containers are not crushed or smashed.

GET THE APP:

Download the BottleDrop app (https://www.bottledropcenters.com/download-app/) and get quick access to all nearby redemption locations.

RETURN YOUR BAGS:

You don't have to go to the redemption centers, go inside, and wait in line. You simply find a location nearby (Burlington Fred Meyer, on Barbur, for example) and return your filled blue bag(s). When at the location, simply scan

the barcode (already attached to your bag) to unlock the outside secure drop door, place your bag(s) inside, close the door, leave, and feel better about not only recycling, but for donating to your child's school through Stephenson PTA. You don't need an account, card, or pin. Simply collect, drop, and go.

HOLIDAYS:

Think of all the space you will save in the recycle bin this holiday season by utilizing the new BottleDrop Give bags. And think of all the \$\$ you can donate with your influx of containers this holiday!

PICK UP YOUR BAGS:

Pick up your blue bags at the school.

12/16 - 12/19: after school (2:00-2:30pm) at the main entrance.

<u>12/20 and beyond</u>: bags will be available in the office in a special container.
