Successful Schools Survey

Shape the future of your student's education!

What is the first thing that comes to your mind when you hear the phrase "successful schools?" We believe that successful schools are safe, healthy and welcoming learning spaces that are inclusive for all students. But we want to hear your thoughts.

In 2019-2020, Portland Public Schools is again partnering with Panorama Education to gather information students and families that will help us improve student experiences across the district. We will survey students in grades 4, 5, 7-10 on their experiences in their classrooms and schools, and families about their perception of the school their child attends.

The survey will cover topics on sense of belonging, school safety, school climate, barriers to family engagement, as well as how students are thinking and feeling about diversity, equity, and inclusion in school.

The current launch date is set for January 27th. The student window is scheduled to be open until February 14th. The family survey until February 28th.

Every parent and guardian in the district will be invited to take the survey, which will be available to families in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese, Russian and Somali. The family survey will be active starting Jan. 27 at

Girls on the Run Information

Hello to all the parents and caregivers at Stephenson! Do you have a 3rd, 4th, or 5th grade girl??? If so, keep reading. If not, <u>keep reading</u> for those that may not see this message to help spread the word!

As a mom of an almost four year old girl (and two boys ages 5 and 6.5 years), I'd like to tell you about a program that has immediately impacted and enriched my life. That program is Girls on the Run! This FUN non-competitive after-school program can be life-changing for the young girls in your life. It may even have an impact on your own life and perceptions! Girls on thRun teaches and helps girls realize their LIMITLESS

POTENTIAL. For 10 weeks, the girls will be given fun and creative (hopefully) lessons that cover topics like loving oneself, developing healthy habits, being supporters for their peers, and even connecting with the community through a project. We also help them achieve the end of the season goal of training for a 5K. Again...non-competitive! Your girl doesn't have to an "athlete" to paticipate in this program. It would be a privilege to be a coach and cheerleader for your girls and give it my best effort to make this a positive experience for them. I am SO excited to be a part of this inspiring program.

I can't do this alone though! Adam Brittle and I are going to coach your girls together. We are looking for a third coach to assist if you have any sparks of interest. Spread the word to your friends...a coach can be ANY member of the community! At present, we have 5 girls signed up. In order to keep the program we need a minimum of 8 girls signed up by February 21. This isn't meant to pressure you, but to inform. You will see fliers in your girls folders. 

Missoula Children's Theatre Instructions for 2019-20

- Signups will be by email to Stephenson.missoula@gmail.com at 4pm on Feb. 18, 2020. Applicants will be accepted based on the time stamp on the email (emails received prior to 4PM will be discarded). Students will only be allowed to participate in one show per year. Assistant Director Positions (generally 5th graders) will be chosen by the Directors during casting and those chosen in the fall will not be able to participate in the spring production.
- 2) Each grade will have a predetermined number of spots. Once those spots are filled, a wait list will be started. In the event that a participant withdraws prior to Missoula week, wait listed students will be contacted in the order that emails were received on signup day.
- 3) Cost will be \$45, cash or check payable to the Stephenson PTA. Payment must be received by Friday, February 21st at noon, or the applicant will be moved to the waitlist. Refunds will not be provided for withdrawal after 2 weeks before the first day of the production, except in the case of illness. After casting, refunds will not be provided, under any circumstances. Please note that if your child cannot make a rehearsal, for any reason after casting, it is up to the Director's discretion as to if they can perform in the production.
- 4) Please note that Kindergartners and First graders will not have rehearsals past 4:30, but all other grades will have rehearsals until 7pm on multiple nights. All participants must be able to attend all rehearsals and shows. No exceptions.
- 5) A request for parent volunteers will be sent out prior to production week for review. Parent assistance is necessary and required in order for the week to proceed smoothly. We will also need help with post show cleanup after the Friday evening production. We are currently in need of 2 host families for the Directors. Please let us know if you are interested!

PURPOSE:

With your deposits, the Stephenson PTA can continue to make an impactful difference in the school experience for all students. Every container you recycle and bag you drop makes a difference.

WHAT CONTAINERS CAN I GIVE?:

FILL YOUR BAGS:

Fill the blue bags with Oregon 10 cent deposit containers. Your bags are prelabeled with a unique barcode so that your bag drop will directly benefit the Stephenson PTA. Plastic, aluminum, and glass can go in the same bag – no need to separate. Try to keep the bags under 20 lbs. Ensure the containers are not crushed or smashed.

<u>GET THE APP</u>:

Download the BottleDrop app (<u>https://www.bottledropcenters.com/download-app/</u>) and get quick access to all nearby redemption locations.

RETURN YOUR BAGS:

You don't have to go to the redemption centers, go inside, and wait in line. You simply find a location nearby (Burlington Fred Meyer, on Barbur, for example) and return your filled blue bag(s). When at the location, simply scan

the barcode (already attached to your bag) to unlock the outside secure drop door, place your bag(s) inside, close the door, leave, and feel better about not only recycling, but for donating to your child's school through Stephenson PTA. You don't need an account, card, or pin. Simply collect, drop, and go.

HOLIDAYS:

Think of all the space you will save in the recycle bin this holiday season by utilizing the new BottleDrop Give bags. And think of all the \$\$ you can donate with your influx of containers this holiday!
