

Hi Stephenson Families,

Thank you again for your support for the Oregon Battle of the Books program this year. We wish our 4th grade team the best at regionals on March 14th. Our next library program are voting for the Beverly Cleary Children's Choice Award (BCCCA) (https://ola.memberclicks.net/bccca-home) in 2nd – 5th grades, the Oregon Reader's Choice Award (ORCA) https://www.olaweb.org/orca in 1st - 5th grades and the Patricia Gallagher Awards for K- 5th grades. Students read the nominated books and then vote for their favorite book. Our vote is submitted to the Oregon Library Association and the books with the most votes, submitted by the students in Oregon, will receive the annual award. Students can find these books in the library. These programs are another way to discuss book awards, book selection and a fun way to encourage reading.

During library and TechSmart visits, students are also working on research skills (1st grade), studying non-fiction (most grades) and using the Google Suite applications (2nd - 5th). In Kindergarten, students continue to work on Lexia, an online literacy reading program. In 3rd to 5th grade students also have a choice to work on Coding, learning a language on Duolingo, practice typing, create stories on My StoryMaker and BookCreator, and reading online books on MyOn. All programs are accessible through Clever and can be found on the PPS Student Portal page https://sites.google.com/apps4pps.net/portal/pps-student-portal?authuser=0. Students will need their school email and password.



Ideally, the coordinator position can be filled by a team of 2 or 3 people.


