Dear Stephenson Learning Community,

Update #3 SW Boones Ferry Bridge & Restoration Project: Planning with the school district and city continues to take place. I will continue working with Site Council to finalize a plan to support student safety during the construction window. It is my hope to share our school plan focusing on student safety including arrival drop off and pick up times during school hours with all families in the next couple of weeks. Most important is if we will be able to continue 5th grade Safety Patrol or not. It would depend on adult support at the crosswalks. If we do not have a strong support system than more than likely we would stop 5th grade Safety Patrol for the rest of the school year. Please see page 2 of FNN this week. The new date is starting March 19, 2020 and lasting for up to seven months, SW Boones Ferry Road will be completely closed from SW Arnold to SW Comus Ct. Please reach out with any questions you may have by either email or phone call.

Wednesday, February 12th is our **Connect to Kindergarten** event for current and new families who will have an incoming K child enrolling at Stephenson. If families are not able to make the event we will have registration packets in the main office. Thank you to PTA for supporting child care that evening for students older than 4 years old from 6:15pm-7:45pm in the Music room 168.

Full School Closure this Summer 2020: Our school building will be CLOSED from June 12th to August 14th this summer for several construction projects including new tile flooring in all hallways and a few classrooms. Both fire alarm wiring work and our new security system which will include additional cameras, ty's, speakers and a one way entrance and exit alarm system. Currently, we are updating a small room to house our school's kiln which has been sitting for years unused. This is exciting news for our school. I will share a full detailed list of all our summer projects as I receive confirmation from PPS Facilities.

Excitement is in the air for the Stephenson Auction on Saturday, February 8th at Oregon Golf Club from 5:00pm-10:30pm. This year's theme is "Saturday Night Live" Tickets are still on sale for the event. The night will be filled with fun and entertainment. Money raised will support our school in many capacities. SW Boones Ferry Bridge & Restoration Project Update: January 30, 2020

City of Portland Environmental Services—your sewer and storm water utility—is beginning construction of a new bridge on SW Boones Ferry Road where it crosses Tryon Creek. The new bridge will improve water flows by replacing an existing small culvert. This culvert cannot handle large flows of water during storms, and it blocks fish and wildlife. The SW Boones Ferry Bridge & Restoration Project will create and restore important connections for fish, wildlife, and people. It will connect trails and pedestrian facilities in the area, help reduce flooding risk, and restore important habitat.

SW BOONES FERRY ROAD CLOSING ON MARCH 19, 2020

Starting March 19, 2020 and lasting for up to seven months, SW Boones Ferry Road will be completely closed from SW Arnold to SW Comus Court.

In order to build the new bridge, crews will need to completely excavate a large section of Boones Ferry Road. SW Boones Ferry Road will be **COMPLETELY** closed to all traffic, including for people driving, walking, or biking. Electronic reader boards and signage will be placed ahead of time to warn travelers of the upcoming closure and to guide people to the recommended detour route. Flaggers will be located at the closure area to direct traffic. Please plan ahead to find alternate routes. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) has approved a traffic control plan. In addition, PBOT and Environmental Services have installed traffic and pedestrian safety improvements along the detour route to make traveling safer and easier during this project.

The map shows the recommended traffic detour route. Map is at <u>www.portlandoregon.gov/bes/BoonesFerry</u>. We encourage people to plan ahead. You may want to find alternate routes or consider alternative work options such as teleconferencing or changing your schedule to avoid traffic, especially during rush hour.

If you use the recommended detour, **please be aware of other travelers, especially people walking or biking.** PBOT Traffic Control Engineers will be monitoring traffic in the area once the road closure begins and will make any necessary adjustments to the traffic control plan. We appreciate your patience and understanding during construction as we work on this important project to restore connections for fish, wildlife, and people.

SCHEDULE

Crews will begin pre-construction activities starting February 7. Major construction activities and the closure of SW Boones Ferry Road will begin on March 19, 2020. Work will be completed in late 2020 or early 2021. The schedule may change due to a variety of factors, including weather, conditions underground, availability of materials and labor, and other unforeseen events. In general, work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, and Saturdays as needed.

WHAT IS HAPPENING NEXT?

In order to build the new bridge, help ensure public safety, and accommodate large and heavy construction equipment, arborists will be clearing brush and removing trees from the project area between February and March 2020. Other pre-construction activities may include marking underground utilities, installing tree protection, installing erosion control measures, staging equipment and materials, and setting up traffic controls. TAG News.....

Dear Stephenson Families,

The TAG testing for our school will take place on **Wednesday February 19th and Thursday February 20th.** Please make every effort to have your child at school on these days. Our testing proctor is currently developing the schedule so we do not know exactly what time specific students or grade levels will be tested, thus it is important for your child to arrive on time and to be present for the entire school day. Please remember

to encourage your child to eat a big healthy breakfast and lunch on these days. We do know that testing will occur in the morning and afternoon.

All of the TAG testing will be paper and pencil this year. Testing can be stressful and some students may not react well to hearing that they will be taking a test. If your child appears stressed about the testing the TAG office suggest telling them that the school needs some students to help try out a few special puzzles and activities to help teachers better understand student problem solving strategies or that they will be taking part in an activity to help teachers see how much Stephenson students know about certain subjects. You know your child best, so please share as little or as much as you believe they need to know. Please remind them to relax and try their best!

The results may take 2 months to come back. You will be notified once we receive the results. Score reports are also mailed to the primary address listed for the student. When the results come back, if your child does not qualify for TAG identification, please tell them that we appreciate their participation in the process. Also, the fact that they were asked to participate tells us that they are incredibly bright students (regardless of the testing results).

Successful Schools Survey

Shape the future of your student's education!

What is the first thing that comes to your mind when you hear the phrase "successful schools?" We believe that successful schools are safe, healthy and welcoming learning spaces that are inclusive for all students. But we want to hear your thoughts.

In 2019-2020, Portland Public Schools is again partnering with Panorama Education to gather information students and families that will help us improve student experiences across the district. We will survey students in grades 4, 5, 7-10 on their experiences in their classrooms and schools, and families about their perception of the school their child attends.

The survey will cover topics on sense of belonging, school safety, school climate, barriers to family engagement, as well as how students are thinking and feeling about diversity, equity, and inclusion in school.

The current launch date is set for January 27th. The student window is scheduled to be open until February 14th. The family survey until February 28th.

Every parent and guardian in the district will be invited to take the survey, which will be available to families in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese, Russian and Somali. The family survey will be active starting Jan. 27 at

Missoula Children's Theatre Instructions for 2019-20

- Signups will be by email to Stephenson.missoula@gmail.com at 4pm on Feb. 18, 2020. Applicants will be accepted based on the time stamp on the email (emails received prior to 4PM will be discarded). Students will only be allowed to participate in one show per year. Assistant Director Positions (generally 5th graders) will be chosen by the Directors during casting and those chosen in the fall will not be able to participate in the spring production.
- 2) Each grade will have a predetermined number of spots. Once those spots are filled, a wait list will be started. In the event that a participant withdraws prior to Missoula week, wait listed students will be contacted in the order that emails were received on signup day.
- 3) Cost will be \$45, cash or check payable to the Stephenson PTA. Payment must be received by Friday, February 21st at noon, or the applicant will be moved to the waitlist. Refunds will not be provided for withdrawal after 2 weeks before the first day of the production, except in the case of illness. After casting, refunds will not be provided, under any circumstances. Please note that if your child cannot make a rehearsal, for any reason after casting, it is up to the Director's discretion as to if they can perform in the production.
- 4) Please note that Kindergartners and First graders will not have rehearsals past 4:30, but all other grades will have rehearsals until 7pm on multiple nights. All participants must be able to attend all rehearsals and shows. No exceptions.
- 5) A request for parent volunteers will be sent out prior to production week for review. Parent assistance is necessary and required in order for the week to proceed smoothly. We will also need help with post show cleanup after the Friday evening production. We are currently in need of 2 host families for the Directors. Please let us know if you are interested!

FILL YOUR BAGS:

Fill the blue bags with Oregon 10 cent deposit containers. Your bags are prelabeled with a unique barcode so that your bag drop will directly benefit the Stephenson PTA. Plastic, aluminum, and glass can go in the same bag – no need to separate. Try to keep the bags under 20 lbs. Ensure the containers are not crushed or smashed.

<u>GET THE APP</u>:

Download the BottleDrop app (<u>https://www.bottledropcenters.com/download-app/</u>) and get quick access to all nearby redemption locations.

RETURN YOUR BAGS:

You don't have to go to the redemption centers, go inside, and wait in line. You simply find a location nearby (Burlington Fred Meyer, on Barbur, for example) and return your filled blue bag(s). When at the location, simply scan

the barcode (already attached to your bag) to unlock the outside secure drop door, place your bag(s) inside, close the door, leave, and feel better about not only recycling, but for donating to your child's school through Stephenson PTA. You don't need an account, card, or pin. Simply collect, drop, and go.
