# From Principal Galindo...

EPHENSON ELEMENTARY



Dear Stephenson Learning Community,

Our first "Kinder Story Time and Tour" is Tuesday, March 10th from 9:45am-10:30am. New Kindergarten students and their families are invited to visit school and participate in our story time in the library with Mr. Rocha and a tour of our three K classrooms. There is no need to RSVP. Please just show up and sign in the main office.

I recently received staffing numbers for the 2020-2021 school year. The good news is that we did not lose any staff reductions. In fact, we received additional staffing by adding a .20 Speech Language Pathologist, (1) 2nd grade teacher and a .5 school counselor. During staff meeting time the staff and I have been discussing various classroom scenarios with the amount of FTE (full time employee) Stephenson received. I've also met with Foundation, Site Council and PTA to share and discuss our FTE as well as to share several options in spending the foundation funds. It is my hope to spend Foundation funds to increase our media specialist from .5 to full time and offer both library and technology to our students. Once one-third of the Foundation funds are removed from our school's account to support the PPS Equity fund, I will use the remaining funds to hire two or three limited-term educational assistants as we did this past year to support students in large size classrooms.

Gen Ed Classrooms for 2020-2021: (3) Kinder garten teachers, (3) 1st grade teachers, (3) 2nd grade teachers, (2) 3rd grade teachers, (2) 4th grade teachers and (2) 5th grade teachers.

We will conduct interviews for our 2<sup>nd</sup> grade vacancy the week of March 16th. Ms. Saunders and Ms. T. Jacobs along with a 1st grade parent will provide support in hopes of making a final recommendation to Human Resources within the same week.

March 9-13 is Spring Missoula Week and it will be a busy one for 64 K-5th grade students. Two performances will take place on Friday, March 13th. 12:30pm for students and 7:00pm is the evening performance for families.

Our next PTA meeting will be a morning meeting on Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup> at 8am in the staff book room 171. We hope to see you there!

Thank you for your continued support and dedication to students and staff of Stephenson Elementary. Don't forget to set your clocks one hour ahead on Saturday evening.



Ideally, the coordinator position can be filled by a team of 2 or 3 people.


