Missoula Children's Theatre Instructions for 2019-20

- Signups will be by email to Stephenson.missoula@gmail.com at 4pm on Sept. 24, 2019. Applicants will be accepted based on the time stamp on the email (emails received prior to 4PM will be discarded). Students will only be allowed to participate in one show per year. Assistant Director Positions (generally 5th graders) will be chosen by the Directors during casting and those chosen in the fall will not be able to participate in the spring production.
- 2) Each grade will have a predetermined number of spots. Once those spots are filled, a wait list will be started. In the event that a participant withdraws prior to Missoula week, wait listed students will be contacted in the order that emails were received on signup day.
- 3) Cost will be \$45, cash or check payable to the Stephenson PTA. Payment must be received by Friday, September 27th at noon, or the applicant will be moved to the waitlist. Refunds will not be provided for withdrawal after 2 weeks before the first day of the production, except in the case of illness. After casting, refunds will not be provided, under any circumstances. Please note that if your child cannot make a rehearsal, for any reason after casting, it is up to the Director's discretion as to if they can perform in the production.
- 4) Please note that Kindergartners and First graders will not have rehearsals past 4:30, but all other grades will have rehearsals until 7pm on multiple nights. All participants must be able to attend all rehearsals and shows. No exceptions.
- 5) A request for parent volunteers will be sent out prior to production week for review. Parent assistance is necessary and required in order for the week to proceed smoothly. We will also need help with post show cleanup after the Friday evening production. We are currently in need of 2 host families for the Directors. Please let us know if you are interested!

On October 14th to October 18th, a cast of Stephenson students will be rehearsing and performing MCT's version of "The Tortoise Versus the Hare". Up to 64 students (grades K-5) who pre-registered on September 24th will be part of this production.

Students will audition for their parts on Monday, October 14th from 2:30 PM to 4:30 PM, followed by the first rehearsal on Monday at 5pm for some characters. Additional rehearsals will be conducted Tues. – Thurs., after school, for 2-4 hours. Although not all cast members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the <u>entire week and be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role</u>. A detailed rehearsal schedule, by cast part, will be distributed at the conclusion of the Monday auditions.

Performances will be Friday, October 18th, 12:45 PM (school show) and 7:00 PM (community show).

T-shirts will be available the week of the show for \$16. Please note that we need two weeks written notice prior to audition day if you choose not to participate for any reason other than illness, or we will need to keep your check.
