Fishbowl Exercise: Reflection



We wanted to explore our emotions in this month's mindfulness practice! The Fishbowl Exercise needs three things, a container (like a fishbowl), slips of paper with various emotions written them, and yourself! Fold the slips of paper and mix them up in your fishbowl. Pull one slip of paper out at a time and try to recall a time that you felt that emotion. You can do this alone or with more people! Be sure to listen to the story the person is telling in reflection of this emotion. You can ask questions, like 'Where do you feel that emotion in your body when you tell that story?'. Telling stories that relate to emotions can help build emotional intelligence for yourself and for others!


