Principal's Report, Carol Campbell: Marshall facilities are sufficient for the most part with a few exceptions. Attendance will be analyzed; calls home may be upcoming. Kate Allen has taken another job but new SW will start in the next week.

Proficiency grading will be "standardized" this year. Teachers working within communities to make grading more consistent and maintain focus on proficiency in the subject matter. Also focusing on equity of learning for underserved and special education. Climate Plan is in progress: staff, students, etc.

Grant remodel: Making progress on interior gutting including toxic materials

Max incident after game update: Students were interviewed. Possible that there were some middle school students there as well as high school students. Video didn't show anything conclusive. Additional assistance at future games from the police department will be available but limited. Additional staff present in the stands for the home games.

After school Max issues: kids are not being safe or respectful while waiting for the Max. Message about public behavior and safety should happen at home. *Trimet is a privilege and a great opportunity for the kids. Possibility of getting a safety video from Trimet. Parent help is needed to educate the kids.

Lunch time Walmart behavior—there are some kids who are stealing and misbehaving.

Several events haven't made it on the calendar; work in progress.

Homecoming dance: Saturday dances were not well attended by parents or students; night games are preferred by the students which makes for a late dance. The carnival was not well attended largely because of poor planning. Dances are problematic and will need more chaperones.

Upcoming: PSAT day tomorrow; seniors get graduation information and a senior class photo, career workshops, etc. Basic Rights Oregon will present to the teachers after the students are dismissed.
