

ACCESS Academy Alternative Program Application for the 2021-22 School Year

Application to ACCESS is through a two-step process.

1. Complete and submit this application and supporting documents.

NOTE: If your student was an eligible applicant in the 2018, 2019 or 2020 ACCESS lottery, your student is exempt from filling out the long version of the ACCESS eligibility application.

2. Complete a PPS School Choice Application (<https://ppsnew.schoolmint.net>), including, if appropriate, an income eligibility form.

It is best practice that a school-based team has convened and discussed the student's educational needs. The team should complete this application, being sure to answer all required questions. In lieu of a team-based meeting, a family who is not able to meet with their neighborhood school may still apply using the Access Application for admission, and a statement of need from an educator/counselor who knows the child best.

Once the application is completed and all required information is provided, the student is eligible for the ACCESS lottery, so long as a SchoolMint application has been submitted as well.
