## Walking Field Trip Permission Form

It is customary for teachers to take their classes on walking field trips in the school community at different times during the school year. The purpose of such walks is varied. Students may observe neighborhood architecture and urban plants and animals or visit interesting places in the community such as the public library, local businesses and parks.

In order to allow flexibility for these valuable activities, this permission will extend for the entire school year. If a parent or guardian is expecting to take his/her student out of school for any reason during the school day, it is important to **notify the teacher and office in advance.**

Separate permission forms will always be issued by the teacher when any form of transportation is involved to or from a field trip or a trip involves an overnight stay or wilderness activity.
