MONDAY CLASSES

3D Printing and Minecraft (Gr. 2-5)

3D printing and Minecraft represent boundless opportunities for creating even our wildest of ideas! In 3D Printing: Minecraft Creations, students will explore the basic concepts of 3D printing and computer-aided design, to bring their most awesome Minecraft creation to life! Students will take their Minecraft design out of the world of Minecraft and learn how to extrude it into a 3D model that can be modified to be printed in 3D. Students are required to have experience with a keyboard and mouse for this class.

To Create a New Account:

Open your internet browser and go to www.Pay4SchoolStuff.com or www.p4ss.com. If using a mobile device, use the Google Chrome internet browser to access the site. • Click on the orange "Login" button on the top left hand menu bar. Click on "Create Parent Account" at the bottom of the screen. Enter your First Name, Last Name, and Email Address. Your Email Address will be used as your login/User ID. Enter and re-enter a Password of your choosing. Enter your Phone Number and Address. • Read and agree to the Terms of Use, then click "Next" on the bottom of the page. Enter the First Name and Last Name of your student. Select the school by specifying the State, County, and School Name from the drop-down lists. Select your students' grade.

Shopping with an Existing Account

To begin shopping for your student, go to Marketplace and directly to an item on your school's payment menu, OR click on the orange "Login" button in the top left hand menu bar. Enter your User Name (e-mail address) and Password in the spaces provided. "Select" link (under "Pay For") next to your child's name if you have an existing account. A screen will appear that shows payment categories on the left. To see a quick preview of items offered under a category, click on the "PREVIEW Items available for purchase" link. **To begin selecting items, you must click on the "SELECT" button on the left side of the page below the heading "YOU MUST READ BEFORE REGISTERING FOR CLASSES." Once you do this, the classes will load below and you will be able to view them . If you do not click on the select button, you will not be able to view and select the classes. If you check out with a zero balance, you have not registered for a class.** If you then do not see the item you are looking for, it has either sold out or is otherwise not available. Select an item by clicking the small checkbox on the left side of the screen, under the "Select" column. If you have any questions about an item, click on the "?" in the upper right hand corner of the item listing. You may be asked to fill out a form, fill in your own price for an item, or select an item with "zero-cost". Click the "Add to Cart" icon on the bottom of the screen. On the Shopping Cart page, you can review or delete your selections, or go "Back" to continue shopping. Click the "Pay Now/Login" icon on the bottom right corner of the Shopping Cart page to complete your purchase.
