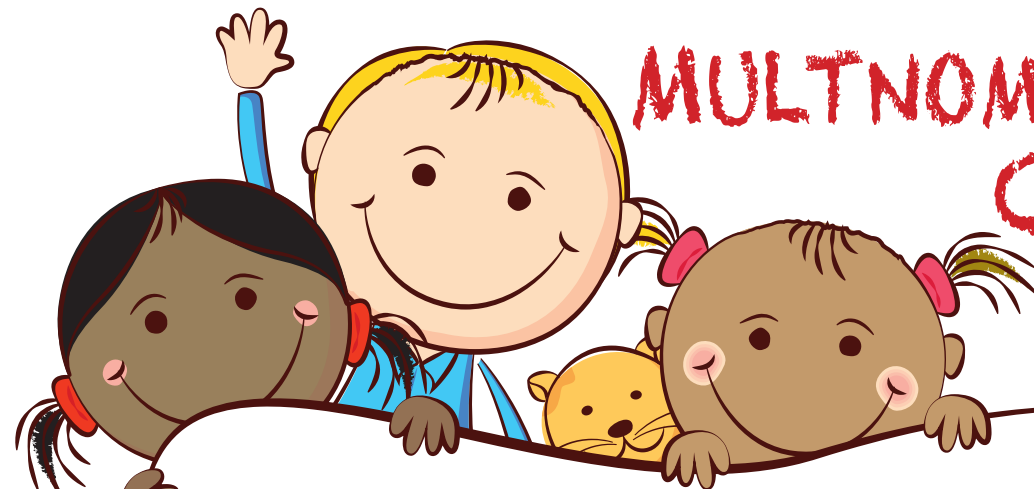


MULTNOMAH EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM

Our professional teaching teams include state licensed, early childhood special education teachers. We require parents to transport their children.












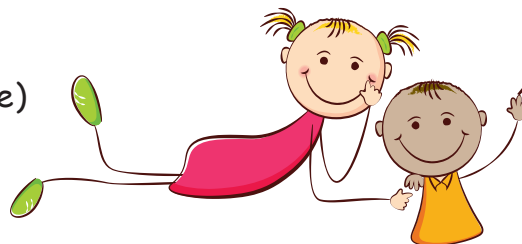
