She has taught English at both Centennial High School and Mountain View High School, as well as being a literary coach at both schools. She began her career as a teacher of the deaf at Mountain View.

She hopes to use her experience as a teacher and an administrator to bring an atmosphere of open communication and cohesiveness to the MLC community. Alexa is excited about the unique offerings of the MLC education structure, and will be focusing on the five traits emphasized at the school: courage, respect, self-discipline, integrity and compassion.

Alexa holds a Doctorate in Educational Leadership from the University of Oregon, an Initial Administrative License and Master's of Education from Lewis and Clark College, and a Bachelor of Arts from Michigan State University.
