Anh earned bachelor degrees from Syracuse University in Inclusive Elementary and Special Education and Sociology, and her master's degree in Curriculum and Instruction from Portland State University. She completed her administrative license at Lewis and Clark College. Anh speaks conversational Vietnamese.

Anh grew up in the Philadelphia area, but now calls Portland home. She enjoys traveling, spending time with family and friends, baking, and coaching girls' lacrosse.
