She moved to Marysville in 2006 and served as a teacher in grades 6-8 until 2014, when she became an instructional specialist, mentoring teachers for grades 4-8.

She got her first taste of instruction as a dual-language student teacher in Costa Rica, then had stints as a special education teacher in Kansas City and Illinois. She attended Northern Illinois University, where she earned a Bachelor of Arts in Education and a Master of Arts in Teaching.
