1. Click on the meeting link your teacher sends or posts.



 If you are on a district device and have never used Zoom before, then you may want to download the <u>Zoom Chrome extension</u>. If you have Zoom downloaded on a personal computer, then click Open zoom.us. If you don't have it installed there is a link to "download and run Zoom" or you can click "join from your browser."
