I am pleased to announce that Gina Roletto, who has served as assistant principal of Cesar Chavez K8 since 2013, will be the interim principal of Scott K-8 for the 2017-18 school year. Gina has been with PPS since 2011, first having served as assistant principal of Vernon K-8.

Gina brings a variety of experience to the Scott community. She had a long and successful career in the Hillsboro School District. Beginning in 1998, she taught elementary and middle school grades and worked as an ESL specialist who strengthened communication between school and families. In 2007, she took on a leadership role as an instructional coach at several schools to implement the district's literacy vision. For two summers, Gina also served as Migrant Summer School Coordinator K-12. She then served as Dean of Students and IB Coordinator at South Meadows Middle School with a focus on creating an academic culture in a brand new school.

Gina earned her Bachelor's in Botany and Master's of Teaching degrees from the University of Washington. She also has an ESOL endorsement and administrative license from Lewis and Clark College. Gina served on the PAT/PPS Workload Committee, continues to serve on the board for Oregon Association of Latino Administrators, and recently was invited to serve on the District-wide Boundary Review Advisory Committee.

Gina says that as a bilingual and bicultural education leader, she intends to support the Scott staff and community in their continued work to provide access to rigorous instruction and resources for students. She wants to bring her leadership style of reflection and empowering staff and students to Scott as they continue to build on strengths that will lead to increased achievement. Gina is eager to learn the story of the Scott community, and looks forward to partnering with the community to do what is best for students.

Gina feels that to continue with her own learning, being open to different perspectives is always important. She enjoys spending time with her family, and attending sports events and concerts.
