Daily Expectations for pre-kindergarten to 5th grade (based on Oregon Department of Education recommendations)

Teacher-Led

Structured, grade-level learning directed and supported by teacher. This might be **live** with teacher online or where student participates in **pre-recorded** lessons or activities.

Examples may include (but are not limited to):

Listening to live or pre-recorded lesson with teacher, listening to read-aloud, participating in class discussion or class meeting.

Student-Led

Activities may be connected to teacher-led learning, led by student, or led by family. Could be **live** with teacher online or where **student completes** recommended activities.

Examples may include (but are not limited to):

Exploring education websites or applications like Dreambox and Lexia; creating materials using BookCreator or Google Apps; independent reading, drawing, singing, dancing, physical activity, flashcards, counting, sorting.

Pre-Kindergarten

Designed to meet the diverse needs of PK families

- PK teachers may provide website guidance and additional learning resources for their own classrooms.

Kindergarten to 5th Grade

Mins: Short for Minutes, the table below represents a day of school. * Social Studies and Science classes can rotate weekly. Other supplemental learning activities for Science and Social Studies may be led by students, family, and/or caregiver.

Teacher: Time that will be Teacher-Led.

Student: Time that will be Student-Led.

2nd Grade and 3rd Grade

- Mathematics: Teacher: 30 Mins, Student: 40 Mins
- Social Emotional Learning: Teacher: 30 Mins
- Language Arts: Teacher: 30 Mins, Student: 40 Mins
- PE and Arts: Teacher or Student: 15-30 Mins, Live is not required

4th Grade and 5th Grade

- Mathematics: Teacher: 45 Mins, Student: Up to 60 Mins
- Social Emotional Learning: Teacher: 30 Mins
- Language Arts: Teacher: 30 Mins, Student: Up to 60 Mins
- PE and Arts: Teacher or Student: 15-30 Mins, Live is not required

After May 8th

Teacher: 45 Mins

- Mathematics: Student: 40 Mins
- Language Arts: Student: 40 Mins

Teacher: 45-60 Mins

- Mathematics: Student: Up to 45 Mins
