In addition to his principal duties, Leo served as Athletic/Activity Director for the Neah-Kah-Nie School District since 2010, starting when he was vice principal at Neah-Kah-Nie High School. He also served on a program request funding committee at a youth foundation.

Leo started his education career as a teacher at Optimist High School in Los Angeles, teaching English, social studies and driver's education to incarcerated students. From 2002 to 2010, he taught English at Sam Barlow High School in Gresham, where he led efforts to align the English curriculum from middle school into high school and developed a Writer's Guide that is used in all Gresham-Barlow School District schools.

Leo is a graduate of Portland State University, where he earned a Bachelor of Arts in English and a Master of Science in School Administration.
