



## Metropolitan Learning Center Celebrates 50 Years of Public Alternative Education

Portland, Oregon—Metropolitan Learning Center (MLC) celebrates its 50<sup>th</sup> birthday on September 15, 2018 with an all-day fair and evening panel discussion at MLC. As the oldest continually operating alternative school in America, MLC has plenty to celebrate. The day will be filled with photo, video, and art displays encompassing the school's entire history from the freewheeling first days in 1968 when students were invited to create their own learning program right up to today where MLC students thrive in a progressive educational environment.

"The founders of MLC created a public school where thinking for oneself was paramount," said celebration organizer and MLC parent, Alisa Welch. "For the past 50 years, MLC has occupied a unique space in Portland Public Schools. It's a true alternative school in that students are honored for their opinions and encouraged to seek out their own interests while still pursuing academic excellence."
