Please send a copy of the nominee's resume along with at least one letter of recommendation outlining why the nominee deserves to be honored with the PIL Foundation *Commitment to Social Justice Award* as described in the award description above. Additional letters of support are encouraged but not required.

The letter of recommendation should provide specific and concrete examples, and please include the following information:

- Nominee's name, title, address, school/organization, and phone number
- Nominator's name, title, address, school/organization, and phone number

Below are questions to consider in your nomination letter to provide more context and further support your nominee's likelihood to be recognized.

- Give an example of programs or initiatives that this individual/organization was a part of that helped promote racial equity and social justice.
- Share examples of collaboration with another individual, department, and/or organization to further inclusivity, racial equity, and social justice.
- In what ways has this individual or organization gone above and beyond the scope of their position to show a commitment to build, sustain, and celebrate an inclusive school and/or community?
- Why should this individual or organization be selected to receive the PIL Foundation Commitment to Social Justice Award over other candidates?
