Olgamar comes to us from Saint Thomas More School in Wisconsin, an EC-8th grade school with an enrollment that includes 89% students of color. In four years as principal, Olgamar cultivated open and active communication between the school and school community, utilizing every available tool, ensured that the school complied with the Protecting Our Children program, implemented a Spanish Immersion Program, and a Middle School Personalized Learning Program.

Before joining Saint Thomas More, Olgamar worked as a bilingual teacher and instructional leader in various public school districts in Wisconsin, including nine years in Green Bay Area Public Schools, as a Bilingual Teacher, Program Support Teacher, Instructional Coach, and Title 1 migrant recruiter, and two years as a Teacher Leader in the Early Childhood Department and in the Office of Multilingual and Global Education in Madison Metropolitan School District. She has a wealth of experience working with low-income students with diverse linguistic and cultural backgrounds.

Before her career in education, Olgamar was a dentist, then owned and operated an importexport business in Mexico City. She speaks fluent Spanish and some French. Olgamar earned a Doctor of Dental Surgery from Universidad Intercontinental; a Bachelor of Science in Education from Silver Lake College; and a Master of Science in Education and Educational Administration from Concordia University.
