Dr. Omogbehin comes to us from the Roosevelt School District in Phoenix, Ariz., where she served as Chief Academic Officer. In that role, she created a district academic profile, overhauled the instructional program and conducted a needs assessment by visiting every district school.

Before moving to Phoenix, Dr. Omogbehin worked in the Houston Independent School District, first as a School Support Officer, then as Chief School Officer overseeing 47 schools. She also worked in San Diego Unified School District for 22 years, as a teacher, staff developer, literacy administrator, vice principal and principal at the elementary, middle and high school levels.

Dr. Omogbehin earned a Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts in English Language from the University of Ilorin in Nigeria; a Master of Arts in Multicultural Education from the United States International University in San Diego; and a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership from San Diego State University.
