Multnomah County has met the <u>Governor's metrics</u> to offer Hybrid in-person instruction. The information in this Reopening guide is intended for students and families to better understand the health and safety protocols that Portland Public Schools has put in place to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in schools.

You can also access this Centers for Disease Control (CDC) <u>tool</u> to help parents, caregivers, and guardians weigh the risks and benefits of available educational options to help them make decisions about sending their student back to school. It is organized to provide parents and caregivers with information on COVID-19, why safely reopening schools is so critical, help you assess your student's and your family's risk of COVID-19; and consider factors that will help you make a choice of instructional format.
