Before joining PPS in 2011, Vanessa taught language arts at Century High School in Hillsboro, and at Eureka High School in Northern California. Vanessa is a native Spanish speaker, and also fluent in French. She holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Humboldt State University, a Masters in Educational Leadership and Policy, and an Initial Administrative License from Portland State University.

Vanessa says she intends to bring a leadership style to Laurelhurst that is both reflective and responsive to the needs of the community. She finds that building strong relationships that empower students, staff and families will help students achieve rigorous academic standards and result in improved achievement. She looks forward to spending time getting to know the Laurelhurst community and building on the strengths of the school.

Vanessa sees herself as a lifelong learner who enjoys nurturing curiosity and a sense of belonging. She enjoys traveling, trying new recipes and flavors, road biking, and spending time with family in the outdoors whenever possible.
