Things to know

Q: What is the Benson Wellness Center?

A: It is a regular doctor's office located inside the school serving students ages 7-21.

Q: Can students still see their regular primary care physician?

A: Yes! Providers can fill in gaps when it is difficult for students to obtain a service with their primary care provider. Examples include confidential services and sports physical.

Q: Does it matter what insurance my student has?

A: We see all students regardless of insurance status.
