  - o Classroom lessons taught by Devin and Jessie, 3-4 push in sessions
    - Discuss differences between elementary and middle
    - Personal organization and tracking school work with multiple teachers
      - Notetaking, paper vs google planner, Canvas
    - Discuss social changes

    - Parent suggested to invite the new 7th/8th graders to get them more comfortable
  - o Elective students select a preference for their elective (options this year are STEM and Art) but math schedule dictates what elective students can do
  - o Encouraged parents to set a weekly date with student to review planner/Canvas/calendar to get students excited about having educational autonomy
  - o Encouraged parents to understand that this is a "wobbly" year and that's okay
- Overview of AVID curriculum Cleary (10-15 min)
  - o 6th grade is a learning curve, ok if it looks wobbly academically
  - o Avid/Spanish will be combined with A and B days so that all students get these executive function strategies in the beginning of the year

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- o Study skills, executive function, and learning how you learn, and learning how to take over your own
- o Tools: binder, folders in computer organized
- o Working to get all 6th graders planners for visual strategy and do it on the computer
