Storybook Parade – As mentioned above our Storybook Parade will be on Monday, March 16th to kick off Spirit Week. This year, we are taking a different approach with the Storybook Parade in that teachers have been working with students on character analysis in their Book Clubs and lessons through our new reading adoption. The intent of the Storybook Parade is for students to think about characters they have been reading about and then use what they have learned to create their character costume. We currently have **127 books overdue** and **366 lost books**. I will be sending out paper notices in the next report card in April. Just as a reminder, here is our policy for lost and/or damaged materials:

If a book is lost or damaged, student(s) will be charged for a replacement book and parents will be emailed. Parents can pay replacement fees, replace book(s) with another book of the same genre, or have students work off the replacement fee (this needs to have written permission from parents before students can work off fines).
