It's almost that time of year and we only have a few more weeks to check out Library books. Last week for checking out books will be May 23-27. Playground Committee Update

The Chief Joseph Playground Committee formed two years ago with the aspiration to improve Chief Joseph's playground for the students and community who use it...adding more opportunities for play, community gathering and connection to nature. As you have likely noticed, we removed 800 square-feet of asphalt this year and planted four trees, including a native Oregon white oak, framed by native plants and three log benches. Over the winter Laura Hartzell, a landscape designer and previous Chief Joseph mom, donated her time to develop a conceptual design based on ideas from many in the community. Our goal is to implement some version of this plan over the next few years with the support of grants and other community fundraising efforts.

Community input is vital to the success of this project - we want your feedback! We are excited to share this concept for a redesigned playground with you. Our plan is to finalize the conceptual design this summer based on your feedback. We will offer several ways for the community to provide feedback over the next two months:

- We will have a table at Chief Joseph's Spring Festival on Friday, May 20. Come by to learn about the project, see the conceptual design and fill out a survey;
 - We will do a brief presentation at the last PTO meeting of the year, June 1. Come see a quick walkthrough of the conceptual design and be directed to the <u>online survey</u> to provide your feedback;
 - Students will get their chance to provide input on the conceptual design at school during the month of May;
 - We will attend the Arbor Lodge and Piedmont neighborhood association meetings in May or June to inform the community, share the conceptual design and allow them to provide input via the online survey;
 - We will provide the link to the master plan and online survey in the rest of this year's

school newsletters.

We are also putting a call out for volunteers to support this effort next year. It will take many of us to bring this opportunity to life; any and all skills are welcome!
