



COVID Testing: The government has recently announced that every U.S. household is eligible again to order 4 free at-home COVID-19 tests using this link. In addition, we offer additional COVID testing options to our students through symptom based testing at school and opt-in weekly testing through OHSU. To sign up for the OHSU weekly testing please do so online here: <u>https://www.ohsu.edu/health/k-12-covid-19-screening-program</u>. Test drop off for Chief Joseph is on Tuesday mornings, and alternate locations are available if you miss drop off at school.
