The Salvation Army is providing their yearly holiday assistance program to help support families with Christmas gifts for their families. Families will need to call 503-493-3925 or go to https://booknow.appointment-plus.com/y73t5hee/ to register for a family intake appointment. Appointments will be on December 19th and 20th. In order to qualify families must have children 12 years old or younger, not signed up with other holiday assistance programs, must bring proof of address and income. You must bring the following to your intake appointment: Picture ID for yourself and some form of ID for each member of the household you are requesting services for; with birthdates for youth ages 0-12. Examples of additional ID: Birth certificate, school ID, report card, medical card. Sign-up soon before all the appointments are taken!
