I hope this email finds you and your family well. Here is a quick update:

This week, teachers are engaging in professional development provided by PPS. Our goal is to provide all staff with the training and tools they need to engage students in virtual learning. Currently, the district is coordinating with the teacher's union to finalize what this will look like. We are also working hard to ensure all students have access to materials and supports. Virtual learning should begin April 6, 2020. It will continue until Governor Brown lifts the Stay Home, Stay Safe order. Until then, students may engage in the on-line tools we have already shared with you. You can access activities through the [student portal](#). Students in grades 4-12, will be receiving their Chromebooks this week. At this time, I am unsure of when the distribution for K-3 will happen, but will let you know as soon as I have information. If you were unable to sign up for a device, the survey will open up again next week. I will resend the link when it is open.
