Dear Families.

As you know, the safety of our students is extremely important to us. One way we ensure safety is through the regular practice of emergency drills. This Wednesday we will be practicing the Lockdown Drill. This drill is required by the state of Oregon to be practiced twice a year. We often refer to this drill as "Locks, Lights, Out of Sight!" We are practicing our response to a situation in which there is imminent danger in the school. Upon notification, teachers will direct students to take cover in the safest place possible. Teachers will then lock the doors, pull blinds, and turn off the lights. Please take the time to discuss this drill with your student. Remind your students that we practice drills in order to be ready if an emergency occurs at school. It is also important to reassure students that they are safe here at school.

On Tuesday, October 9th, we will be practicing a reunification drill after school. In the case of a large scale emergency, we need to accurately and efficiently reunite students with parents and/or approved emergency contacts. We are looking for 2-3 students in each class to participate in the drill. Please watch for a parent letter to come home next week with details on this drill. Please remember to update your emergency contact information with the front office. We can only release your student to people who are named on the contact list, and marked as able to pick up students from school.

This Friday is Principal's Coffee. I hope to see many of you there. I will be giving an update on our new literacy adoption. I also like to maintain an open dialogue and receive feedback from you.
