Most of you had questions about borrowing policies. I have included a few of them here for easy access; see our website (link above) for more information on Library Policies.

#### Grade Level Policies for checking out books:

**Kindergarten** checks out 1 book at any given time. **1st Grade** checks out 2 books at any given time; 1 Leveled Reader & 1 book of their choice.

**2nd Grade** checks out 2 books at any given time; only 1 Graphic Novel (GNOV) out at a time.

**3rd Grade** checks out 3 books at any given time; only 2 Graphic Novels (GNOV) out at a time.

**4th Grade** checks out 4 books at any given time; only 2 Graphic Novels (GNOV) out at a time. **5th Grade** checks out 5 books at any given time; only 2 Graphic Novels (GNOV) out at a time.

If you have any questions, please feel free to stop by the Library. I am in the building Monday – Wednesday and Ms. Julie is in Wednesday – Friday.
