- Welcome back to another year at Duniway! This weekly calendar is a communication piece that your child will bring home in their homework folder at the beginning of each week. The calendar details homework assignments, important dates coming up, notes and reminders from me, as well as the units we are currently studying in the classroom.

- Each week we will have a Crossword Puzzle for homework (usually on Wednesdays). This weekly assignment requires close reading and comprehension practice. Students will need to read the content a minimum of two times. This will count as reading homework. Students do not need to do their reading log homework in addition. However, students are always welcome to do additional reading if they choose to.
- Every Tuesday and Thursday will have a 2-minute "quickfacts" test to work on multiplication fluency. Please support your child at home with practicing their multiplication facts 2-12 so they can work towards the end of the year benchmark goal of completing 38-40 mixed facts in 2 minutes. On Thursday we will start with our "2x" facts! I will distribute triangle flash cards next week.
