Unfortunately my home printer conked out last night so I was not able to print the letter in color. I have attached a copy of the original incase your child would like to see better photographs. I do not expect your child to include any pictures in their letter back to me, but they are welcome to do so.

We expect potable drinking water to return to Duniway water fountains any day now. In the mean time, please make sure your child has a water bottle for use at school every day. Our school's lost and found collection is already growing— please remember to label lunch bags and water bottles, as well as all clothes items. Thank you to those of you who have sent in the \$45 for school supplies. If donating funds at this time creates a hardship for your family in any way, please let me know.
