**Tier One Interventions** are programs that all students may access. About 80% of students at Lincoln perform well with these “universal” supports.

**Tier Two Interventions** are programs that about 20% of students might need in order to succeed academically and social/emotionally at Lincoln.

Students access Tier Two interventions through referrals to the Student Support Team and parent permission.

**Tier Three Interventions** are programs that about 5% of Lincoln students require in order to make adequate academic progress.

Students access Tier Three interventions through the Student Support Team and/or Special Education referral and evaluation.

**Lincoln’s Academic Programs** are reviewed for effectiveness for all students, for students by race, and for students by disability status.
