## Important Dates

- ➤ ALL 2<sup>nd</sup> graders had the opportunity to complete the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT7). Nominations for testing in math and reading are still necessary for this grade level.
  - Testing Dates were: September 25th-October 22nd
- > District will provide results prior to Parent Teacher Night in form of letter.
- All students who qualify with an SBAC score will be notified in September (prior to parent teacher conferences) and IDPF will need to be completed by parent.
- Deadlines for ALL Nomination/Placement Forms (IDPFs)
  - Nov. 13th To Schools
    Nov. 16th To TAG Dept.
- TAG Nomination Testing
  November 2017 February 2018
- Complete the K-8 Student Survey (emailed and available at school) and return to teacher as soon as possible.

#### TAG ID Process

- The parent and teacher fill out the front of the Nomination/Permission (IDPF) form, to recommend a PPS K-12 student for TAG testing/identification. TAG Facilitator completes the rest.
- 2. School submits this form to the PPS TAG Department by November 16, 2017. No IDPFs will be accepted after this date.
- 3. Proctors will be working with schools to schedule assessment dates.
- 4. Schools make the final identification decisions after receiving scores.
- 5. Letters are sent to notify families of eligibility from the PPS TAG Office late spring 2018.

- How does my child demonstrate learning expectations?
- Do you use pre/post assessments?
- How will you communicate the strategies used to address my child's rate and level of learning?

# Strategies to Address a Student's Rate and Level of Learning

- 1. Flexible Grouping
- Tiered Lessons
- 3. Curriculum Acceleration
- 4. Compacting learning a portion in less time
- 5. Independent Study/Project
- 6. Cluster Grouping
- High Level Questioning

Other strategies and interventions for our building...

- 1. Oregon Writing Festival May 5th (4th/5th): \$40/each student
  - 2. Science Fair (3rd and 5th grade)
  - 3. Late Opening classes (4) Science related
  - 4. Continued Staff Training
