

1	Staffing		<p>Lost 1.8 fte, general decline in enrollment</p> <p>Sped was cut to .5 but Amber has an extra .5 instructional specialist so she can stay full time</p> <p>Cut 1 para--safety issue</p> <p>They said they'd be staffing at 19-20 levels but they're not sticking to that. They're staffing next year's 2nd grade based on CDL numbers which they said they weren't going to be doing.</p> <p>We won't have to cut any licensed teachers--Carolina Martinez is retiring so there's a vacancy and Anna Cornett can move to 5th grade.</p>	<p>Why are people leaving? Is it charters and private because parents are tired of public ed being underfunded?</p> <p>Do we want a letter from site council or do we want to wait? Send the letter.</p>

		<p>will monitor hallway</p> <p>Symptom space--PPS will provide N95 masks, gown, gloves</p> <p>Classroom teachers--disposable masks if teachers ask, spray sanitizer</p> <p>Handwashing protocol--sanitizer at entry to building, whenever they come into the room they wash hands, sanitizer when they leave</p> <p>What will pickup and dropoff look like? Staggered by grade and families can wait for siblings to enter and leave because kids all need to be visually scanned.</p> <p>Can we use volunteers? Not allowed in building, and visual health scans must be pps or mesd employees.</p> <p>Where to start??? Amber will figure out which teachers will and won't return. Then she will do a survey that makes more sense so parents know what they're voting for. The problem is that we don't have enough info from PPS on daily schedules, etc.</p> <p>Is PPS thinking about parents and their ability to actually drop off and pick up 2 hours later? That's a logistical issue for parents as well as for teachers who have their own kids.</p> <p>There's also a high likelihood that whatever we start doing now will end</p>	<p>what it will look like yet.</p>

Some are doing hybrid with cdl, some are doing hybrid with simulcast.</p> <p>Right now we have students 2x/wk to access cdl at school with support staff on T, Th mornings, MW afternoons for math and reading. 13 staff members + 2 mesd for 17 kids. Half of each on any given day.</p> <p>What's the plan for tech in classrooms now that all the chromebooks have been sent home? No chromebooks at school, kids will keep them at home for async learning. Amber was told to hold off on purchasing replacement chromebooks because PPS is working on that.</p>
