Faubion Standard Dress Requirements

School uniforms are required for students in Kindergarten-8th grade. Students in preschool and pre-kindergarten may opt to wear school uniforms, but it is not required. **Uniforms are to be worn every day from the first day of school until the last.** There will be the opportunity for "free dress" days, students are expected to follow all dress code standards.

Please read below to clarify what the standard dress should be to ensure that your child is in correct dress at the start of the new school year.

Tops: Navy blue, white, gray and red. Solid colors with collar (turtlenecks count) and either short or long sleeve. Bare waists, bare midriffs, bare backs and low necklines are not permitted.

<u>Sweaters and sweatshirts:</u> must be navy blue, white, gray or red. The collar from the shirt underneath must be showing.

Bottoms: Short, pants, skirts, jumpers, skorts, capris must be khaki/tan, black or navy. Bottoms must be plain, non-patterned. Denim jeans are not included. Belts suggested for belt loops. Bottoms should fit properly and not sag below the waist. Shorts/skirts may be no more than 2 inches above the knee. *Leggings are permitted underneath skirts or dresses only and must be khaki, black, white, or*



navy.

Dresses: May be red, navy, white, khaki or black and must either have a collar or a collar must be worn underneath. Dresses must be solid in color and may not hit more than 2 inches above the knee.



Socks and tights: Tights must be solid colors, either khaki/tan, black, white or navy. Socks may be of any color and/or pattern.

Shoes: Shoes must be closed toe. Sandals need to have a heel strap (no slides or flip flops). Boots are permitted. Heels may not be worn inside the classroom.

<u>Coats</u>: Coats may be of any color or style but may not be worn inside the classroom.

Hats: Hats, hoods, beanies, etc., may not be worn in building. Only religious head coverings are allowed. Solid color sweatshirts with hoods may be worn; however, hoods must be down while in the building.

Swag: Students may wear Faubion, Concordia, or 3 to PhD gear that is not modified any day. If students are in swag, t-shirts without a collar are acceptable. Tank top may not be worn.
