In addition, the PTA works with teachers to ensure all students have the materials they need.

Our classrooms will be using shared materials as an integral part of our program. We emphasize the creation and maintaining of a cooperative and healthy community in many ways (daily meetings, explicit problem solving, mindful moments, etc). We have found that sharing supplies adds much to building a strong community. We also recognize the importance of individuality and personal responsibility and so have addressed those values in organizing supplies in the following way:

These items <u>should be clearly marked</u> with your child's name:

- 1 black & white marbled pattern composition book
- 3 2-pocket folders (red, blue and yellow)
- 1 box 24-count colored pencils (please no more than 24)
- 1 Pink Pearl eraser
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener with lid
- 1 supply box not to exceed approximately 9" x 5.5" x 2.5"

These items <u>will be pooled</u> for common use throughout the year (<u>do not mark</u> with name):

- 2 boxes facial tissue
- 2 canisters of antimicrobial wipes
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 black **fine tip** Sharpie markers
- 4 black **ultra-fine tip** Sharpie markers
- 1 box thick tipped Crayola markers
- 1 box 24-count Crayola crayons
