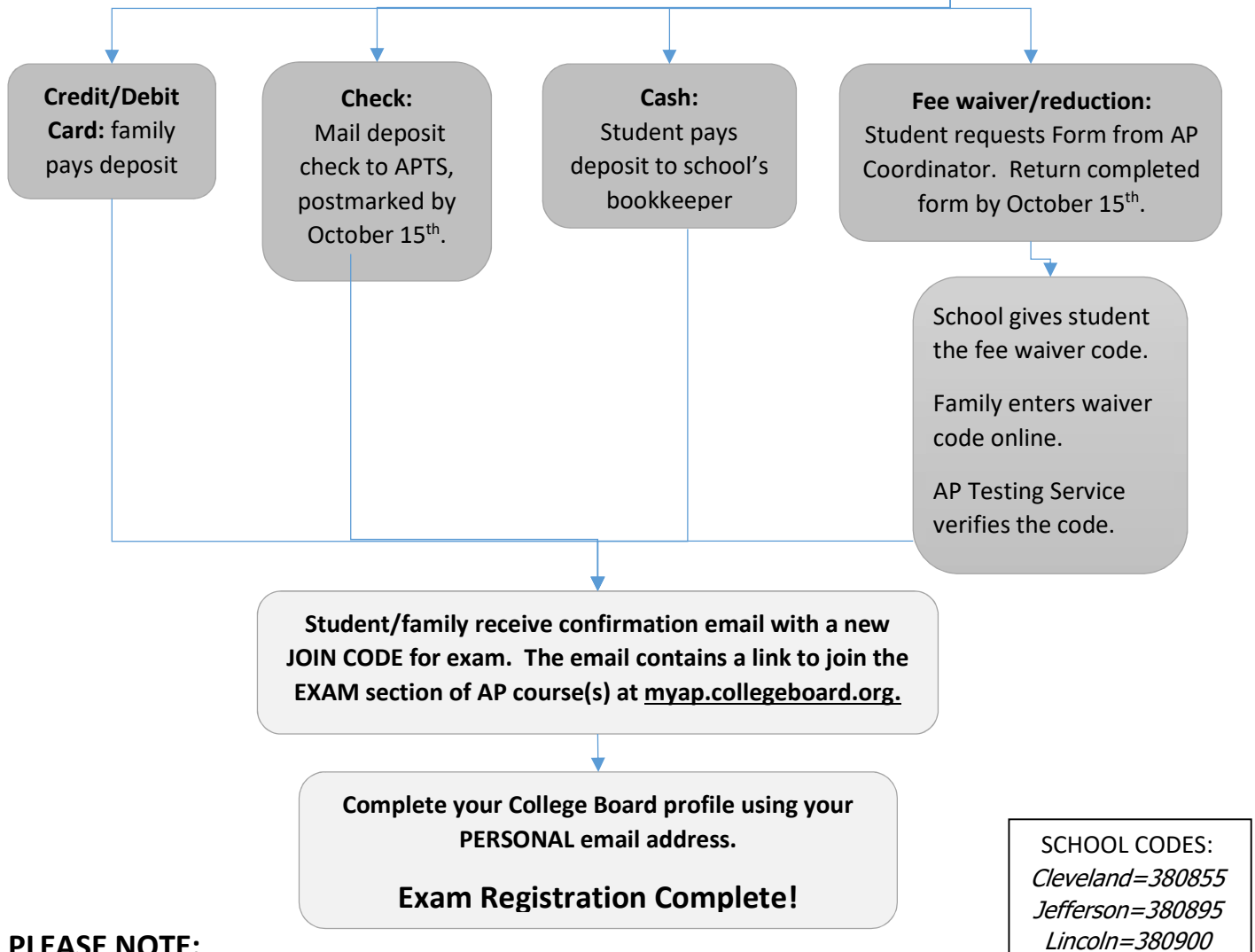


# THE AP EXAM REGISTRATION HAS MOVED TO FALL.

- You **MUST be registered** by November 1, 2019 to take the exam.
- The \$40 per exam deposit is non-refundable after November 1, 2019.
- Families will receive monthly fee balance invoice reminders. Balance due March 30, 2020.

# It is time to register for AP Exams!

Registration runs from October 1 to November 1.

- You **MUST** register in order to take an exam. **November 1<sup>st</sup> is the LAST day to register.**
- **No walk-ins** will be permitted. You must have registered for an exam to take one.
- If planning to take two exams scheduled for the same day or time, register online as normal. In February, you will receive further information regarding which exam you will take on the scheduled date and which you will take on a different scheduled date.
- The full cost of each exam is \$94. AP Research and Seminar are \$142 each.
- Parent or Guardian permission is required.

**Exams will be administered again at the Portland Expo Center in North Portland.** AP Japanese and Chinese will take place at the BESC at 501 N. Dixon St.

- Week 2. May 11<sup>th</sup> – May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020
