2020 AP Exam Administration

EXAM DATES: May 4 – 8, 2020 & May 11 – 15, 2020

- **MORNING:** ARRIVE at 7:15 AM; Check-in begins at 7:30 AM; Exam begins at 8:00 AM and ends at the approximate times listed above.
- **AFTERNOON:** ARRIVE at 11:15 AM; Check in begins at 11:30 AM; Exam begins at 12:00 PM and ends at the approximate times listed above.
- **NOTE:** Spanish Language and Music Theory run longer due to extra recording requirements. Please bring extra food.
- Students are not allowed to leave any AP exam early.

LOCATION:

- Most AP Exams will take place at the **Portland Expo Center**.
- **AP Chinese and AP Japanese exams will take place at the BESC (501 N. Dixon, Portland).**
- The Expo Center and BESC can get **very cold!** PLEASE bring clothes for layering.
- Students testing with a College Board approved accommodation will take their exams at their high school.

WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND that students are **dropped off, carpool or use TriMet.**

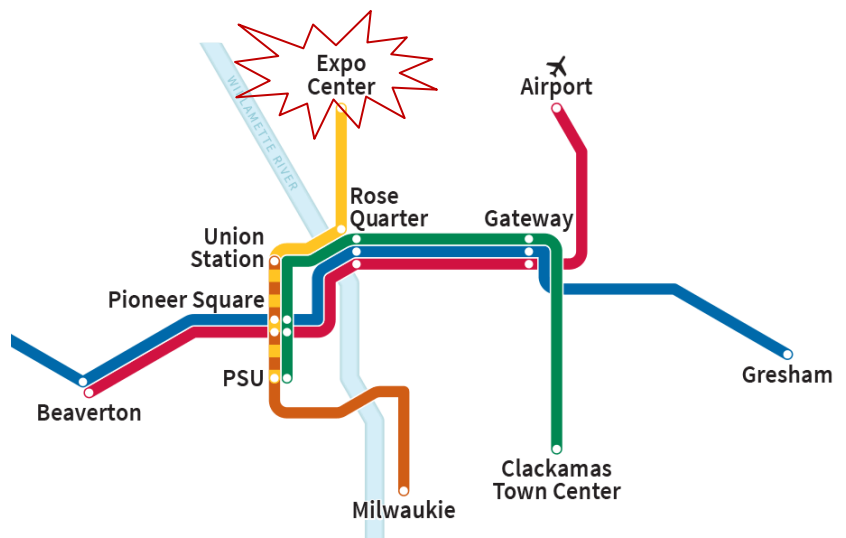
Students who arrive after the start of the exam will NOT be admitted.
