GETTING TO THE PORTLAND EXPO CENTER

WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND that students are **dropped off, carpool or use TriMet.** Students who arrive after the start of the exam will NOT be admitted.

TriMet:

Parking: Free parking vouchers will be distributed at the end of the exam.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING TO THE EXAM?

- Your photo ID** (either a government or school issued photo ID)
- At least two sharpened #2 pencils with erasers (mechanical pencils are not permitted)
- At least two black or dark-blue ball point pens for free response (highlighters and white-out are not permitted)
- A graphing calculator for Biology, Calculus AB/BC, Chemistry, Physics, and Statistics (see calculator guidelines at www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators). Students may bring 2 calculators but are not permitted to share calculators during the exam. Make sure your calculator has fresh batteries.
- Ruler or straightedge (for the Physics exams only)
- Snack/water in a clear Ziploc bag kept separate from purse or backpack
- Warm clothing for layering
- A watch that does not beep or connect to the internet (in case the exam room clock can't be easily seen)

WHAT ABOUT ELECTRONICS?

- Electronic equipment (phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology of any kind, laptops, tablet computers, Bluetooth devices, portable listening or recording devices—MP3 player, iPod®, etc.—cameras or photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, separate timers of any type, watches that beep and any other electronic or communication devices) are prohibited in the exam room and break area.
- If brought to the testing site, these devices will be turned in to AP staff prior to entering the exam area and will be returned at the end of the exam. If a student uses or is seen with any of these electronic items in the testing room or during the break, they will be confiscated and the student will be dismissed from testing. If a phone, watch or other electronic device rings, beeps, etc. in the exam room during the test, it may invalidate EVERYONE'S test in the room.

WHEN DO EXAMS BEGIN AND END?

Morning - Doors open at 7:15. Sign-in begins at 7:30. Exams should conclude at *approximately* noon.

Afternoon - Doors open at 11:15. Sign-in begins at 11:30. Exams should conclude at *approximately* 4:00 pm.

STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE AP EXAMS EARLY.
