- State of the Union (Kristina Howard) 10 minutes
  - o 3 days of dance assemblies
  - o New staff member: Kristie Rivera
    - Role: Student support, hallway sweeps, restorative justice, etc.
  - o MAP Testing Update
    - 50% or more of students will meet or exceed their individual growth goals
    - Families will get scores reports by the first week of March (likely)
    - MAP scores predict that 281 students are projected to NOT pass SBAC grade level benchmarks in reading, 212 meeting or exceeding
    - MAP scores predict that 378 students are projected to NOT pass SBAC grade level benchmarks in math, 115 meeting or exceeding
    - Reading average stats
      - 6th grade averaging at 5th grade level
      - 7th grade averaging around a 6th grade level
      - 8th grade averaging around a 7th grade level
    - Math average stats
      - 6th grade averaging at 4th grade level
      - 7th grade averaging around a 5th grade level
      - 8th grade averaging around a 6th grade level
